### Introduction



#### Definition

- $\mathcal{P}$ -algebra :  $\mathcal{A} = (V, \mathcal{P}, R)$  where
  - $V = \oplus V_n$  is a graded vector space,
  - $\mathcal{P}$  is a finite set of bilinear maps over V,
- R is a set of relations based on elements of  $\mathcal{P}$ . Hilbert series of  $\mathcal{A}$  :

$$\mathcal{H}_{\mathcal{A}}(t) = \sum_{n\geq 0} \dim(V_n) t^n.$$

- Compute the hilbert series of a free *P*-algebra over one generator of degree one.
- **2** Prove the freeness of a given  $\mathcal{P}$ -algebra.

#### Definition (Loday 1998)

A dendriform algebra  $(\mathcal{A},\succ,\prec)$  :

- $\mathcal{A}$  :  $\mathbb{K}$  vector space,
- $\succ$  and  $\prec$  : bilinear maps,
- relations :

$$\begin{cases} (a \prec b) \prec c &= a \prec (b \prec c + b \succ c) \\ a \succ (b \succ c) &= (a \star b) \succ c \\ (a \succ b) \prec c &= a \succ (b \prec c) \end{cases}$$

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An another way to write the relation :

$$(a \prec b) \prec c = a \prec (b \star c),$$

$$(\prec) \prec = \prec (\star).$$

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The syntactic tree representations :



 $\mathcal{A}$ , free dendriform algebra over one generator of degree one represented by complete binary trees which internal nodes are labeled by  $\{\prec, \succ\}$  with the relations :











#### Fact

The family  $\mathcal{F}$  of complete binary trees labelled by  $\{\succ, \prec\}$  and avoiding



spans the free dendriform algebra over one generator.

#### Corrollary

$$\dim(A_n) \leq C_n.$$

#### Definition (Malvenuto-Retenauer 1995)

$$\mathsf{FQSym} := \bigoplus_{n \ge 0} \mathbb{K}[\mathfrak{S}_n].$$

In the basis  $\mathbf{F}$ , the product is given by the shifted shuffle :

$$\mathbf{F}_{\sigma}\mathbf{F}_{\tau} = \sum_{s \in \sigma \boxplus \tau} \mathbf{F}_{s}$$

#### Definition

- $v = v_1 \cdots v_m, w = w_1 \cdots w_n$ 
  - $v \sqcup w = v$  if n = 0,
  - $v \sqcup w = w$  if m = 0,
  - $v \sqcup w = (w \sqcup v_1 \cdots v_{m-1})v_m + (w_1 \cdots w_{n-1} \sqcup v)w_n$ .

 $v \square w := v \sqcup w[\max(v)]$ , where  $w[k] = (w_1 + k)(w_2 + k) \cdots (w_n + k)$ .

If  $\sigma = 312$  and  $\tau = 12$  :

$$\begin{split} \mathsf{F}_{312}\mathsf{F}_{12} &= \ \mathsf{F}_{31245} + \mathsf{F}_{31425} + \mathsf{F}_{34125} + \mathsf{F}_{43125} + \mathsf{F}_{31452} \\ &+ \mathsf{F}_{34152} + \mathsf{F}_{43152} + \mathsf{F}_{34512} + \mathsf{F}_{43512} + \mathsf{F}_{45312}. \end{split}$$

### Dendriform structures FQSym

$$\mathbf{F}_{\sigma} \prec \mathbf{F}_{\tau} := \sum_{\substack{\gamma \in \sigma \square \tau \\ \gamma_{n+m} = \sigma_n}} \mathbf{F}_{\gamma},$$

and

$$\mathbf{F}_{\sigma} \succ \mathbf{F}_{\tau} := \sum_{\substack{\gamma \in \sigma \overline{\square} \tau \\ \gamma_{n+m} = \tau_m[n]}} \mathbf{F}_{\gamma}.$$

Remark :  $\overline{\square} = \prec + \succ$ .



 $\dim(\mathcal{A}_n) \geq C_n.$

#### Theorem (Loday 1998)

Hilbert series of  $\mathcal{A}$ , the free dendriform algebra over one generator of degree one :

 $\sum_{n\geq 1}C_nt^n.$ 

#### Theorem (Novelli 2014)

A basis of  $\mathcal{A}$  : the family  $\mathcal{F}$  of complete binary trees labeled by  $\{\succ, \prec\}$  and avoiding

Theorem (Foissy 2007)

FQSym is a free dendriform algebra.

Theorem (V. 2014)

Freeness of  $\textbf{FQSym}\approx$  bijection between permutations and a family of trees.

#### Corrollary

If 
$$\mathcal{H} = \sum_{n \ge 1} n! t^n$$
 and  $\mathcal{G} = \sum_{n \ge 1} C_n t^n$ , then :
$$\mathcal{G}^{-1} \circ \mathcal{H} = \sum a_n t^n$$

with  $a_n \in \mathbb{N}$ .
